1. Introduction and Background

In March 2007, the European Volunteer Centre (CEV) has launched a call for research papers on volunteering within its network of members, partners and supporters in order to assess the state of the art of volunteering research in Europe. The research call aimed at collecting from each partner organization information on the most relevant and interesting pieces of research on volunteering and related topics. CEV has asked its members and partners to classify the references into 10 different categories (see list below). The analysis of the returned information provides an indicative overview of the areas covered by research and existing gaps. The list of references may serve for anyone interested in volunteering research across Europe to access the most relevant pieces of research identified by CEV members and may contribute to identify a strategy on comparable research on volunteering in Europe

By August 2007, CEV has received references of **196 pieces of research**, sent by **28 organizations** from **22 European countries and Israel**.

The results of the collected data analysis is presented in second chapter. The third chapter regroups all pieces of research according to the category they belong to. Finally, you will find in the third chapter detailed information about every single piece of research that has been reported to us, presented in alphabetical order and by country.

2. Research Results

The analysis of collected data is of descriptive nature limited by the research set-up: Although it would be interesting to have an overview of the total number of research documents per country and to make a regional comparison, the nature of this compilation does not allow for that kind of analysis. Firstly, our members and partners were asked to send only the 10 most relevant pieces of research per country, and, secondly, there are for some countries more than one responding organisations, which consequently resulted in more than 10 references per country in some cases. The results shall be taken as purely indicative and informative without representative value. In addition, the fact that some countries have sent less than 10 references and that the organisations of some countries have not answered the research call does not necessarily mean that research on volunteering is less developed in these countries.

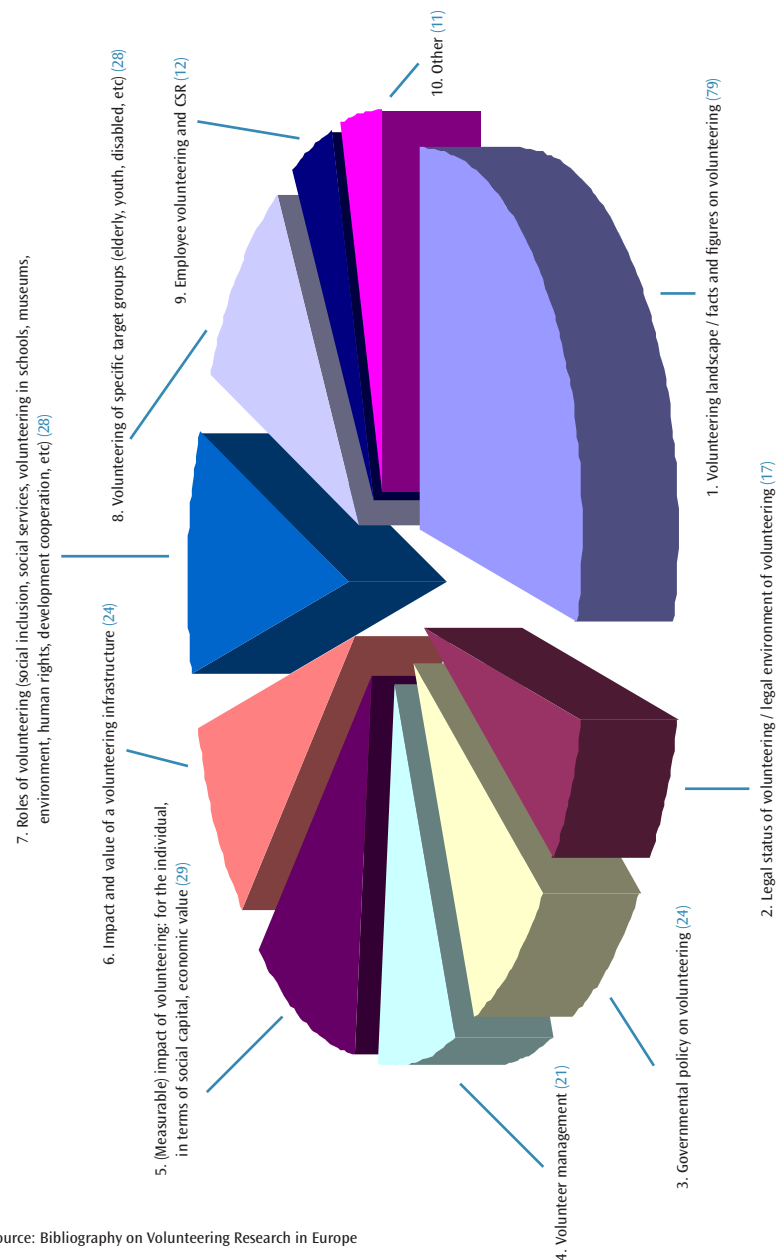
The references are classified according to the following categories:

1. Volunteering landscape / facts and figures on volunteering
2. Legal status of volunteering / legal environment of volunteering
3. Governmental policy on volunteering
4. Volunteer management
5. (Measurable) impact of volunteering: for the individual, in terms of social capital, economic value
6. Impact and value of a volunteering infrastructure
7. Roles of volunteering (social inclusion, social services, volunteering in schools, museums, environment, human rights, development cooperation, etc)
8. Volunteering of specific target groups (elderly, youth, disabled, etc).
9. Employee volunteering and CSR
10. Other

The results of that analysis are presented in Chart 1: Most of the references relate to the first category **“Volunteering landscape / facts and figures on volunteering”** (79), followed by category 5 **“(Measurable) impact of volunteering: for the individual, in terms of social capital, economic value”** with 29 references. The category with the fewest references is category 9 **“Employee volunteering and CSR”** (11) followed by category 2 **“Impact and value of a volunteering infrastructure”** (17)¹.

¹10th category “Other” has 12 references but we can not count it as comparable thematic category.

The references in all the other categories are equally spread (between 20 and 30). Please note that the list of references per category exceeds the total of 196 pieces of research, since multiple choice for each piece of research was possible, i.e. some of the references were classified in more than one category. Therefore, the total number of references for this analysis sums up to 273.

Although the possibilities for the data analysis are limited, some **conclusions** can be drawn on the different categories in which research is scarce or particularly abundant.

- The first category “**Volunteering landscape / facts and figures on volunteering**” is the only one where all of the countries and organisations have reported at least one relevant research.
- Very few countries have studies on the “**Legal status of volunteering**” (category 2). Most of the pieces of research reported under this category are focusing on the legislative needs of the respective countries regarding the volunteering and the obstacles that existent legal framework creates for the practitioners in the volunteering sector.
- It is interesting to note that in the 3rd category “**Governmental policy on volunteering**”, there is only 2 references for the whole of Eastern European region (two pieces of research conducted on regional level in South Eastern Europe).
- 75% of the references reported in category 6 “**Impact and value of a volunteering infrastructure**” stem from Israel.
- In category 7 “**Roles of volunteering**”, most of the collected research relates to the role of volunteering in fighting social exclusion while within category 8 “**Volunteering of specific target groups**”, research on youth and migrants / ethnic minorities prevails.
- Poland accounts for 25% of the research identified in category 9 “**Employee volunteering and CSR**” (the category with the fewest references). In Portugal and Slovakia there are two relevant researches in that category, while in Croatia, Denmark, France and Germany, there is only one. It seems that most of the countries do not have any significant research conducted in that field.
- Category 10 “**Other**” covers themes as education, history, social participation, cooperation between public and volunteering sector, online volunteering and organisational behaviour of volunteers. There are also several handbooks and one philosophical report.
- A recurrent feature is that some of the pieces of research focus more widely on civil society, the “non-profit” sector, or “social economy” especially in Germany. In Sweden, a special focus of research is often put on “membership of organizations”, that is seen as a prominent form of volunteer engagement.

Finally, this research call has collected many valuable pieces of research on volunteering in Europe and proved that volunteering research does exist – with some differences according to the areas covered and differences across countries in terms of the abundance of research available. Contacts with the responding partners suggest that in some countries volunteering research is still in its initial phase, while in others with a well-developed volunteering infrastructure very detailed and specialized research into volunteering has been carried out.

Interestingly, there is no comparative analysis across Europe on volunteering nor a representative annotated bibliography on volunteering research. This is clearly an area of future development to describe the volunteering landscape in Europe and to define areas of further action to promote, to recognize and to facilitate volunteering and to make it more effective.

3. Category tables

You will find below all reported references classified into each of the 10 categories. The tables contain basic information on all of the references such as title, author, country and year of publication. Within the category, the references are listed alphabetically by country with their unique ID and page where more detailed information can be found. The ID corresponds to “research publication”, RP, followed by the respective identification number of the research in the third chapter. It is important to mention that research reported from the UK is separated nationally (England and Scotland), as both of the organisations contributing to this bibliography focused on national researches only. In addition, there is research focusing on more than one country, namely on SEE (South Eastern Europe).
