## *Do it yourself: How to build a youth centre?*

- on organization level: we involve all members, everyone had own role in project and felt included
- medias: we always gave them complete information on time
- local government: we presented all benefits for local community
- citizens: we presented all benefits for them, especially for youth in our community
- donors: we promote them during our activities

## *Video and You Tube as tools to promote volunteering*

- Each organization can make small investments to use video as promotional, educational and documentation tool.
- It is quite easy to learn how to operate with camera and with simple editing tools. Produced materials can be shared online or on CDs or DVDs.
- Volunteers can be guided to record their involvement and share it with organization, other volunteers and on line.
- CEV members can use CEV on line community to share video materials or use free IT tools like YouTube.
- We can think of recruiting volunteers that will work on video production.
